Enrollment Update

- 644 students at both schools
- **Remote Learning and Connectivity**
 - Continuing remote learning at both schools
 - Provide Microsoft Surface Pros for students as well as Internet connection
 - Provide help and support with troubleshooting for these accessories

- MAPs will be taken next week and will be virtually proctored
- Goals are being recorded
- Incentives are put into place to reward students and encourage them to improve their scores

2021-2022 math program- McGraw Hill

- Reviewing this new math program to potentially implement at CLA next school year
- Reason for the new math program is because it is up to date, has more structure, and instructional pieces are more adequate

2021-2022 School Calendar

- Any comments for this academic calendar (improvements, changes, etc)
- Veteran's Day
 - First time it was not taken off this year
 - There was an impact felt this year as some parents had it off while their students did not
- Having both schools have the same week schedules
- Possibly consider having older kids get out first and then the younger kids also get out second
 - This can help with the older students that pick up their younger family members
- Send out survey to parents to ask about feedback for the calendar (specifically looking at the Monday's)
- In school session next academic year will depend on the incidence rates in the community

Local COVID Positivity/Cases

- Adams14
 - 8.66% positivity and has a 478 per 100,000 incidence rate currently
- CDC wants community positivity rate to be <5% in order to bring kids back to school
- Littleton: 6.16% positivity, Douglas: 7.87% positivity, Brighton: 11.27% positivity

Survey Results

- Conducted survey in regard
 - 283 families in total that partook in the survey
 - 71 families we could not get a hold of
- Some questions from surveys
 - Resources that were available to them
 - COVID positivity
 - Commerce city positivity rate
 - Currently still tallying up the results
 - Results will be available during the next meeting

Planning/Open Discussion

- Parents appreciate all the communication from teachers and office staff that let parents know how their students are doing in their classes and what they need to finish
 - Prefer direct teacher communication especially before they are failing. Text messages would be easier
 - Both schools are using text communications in order to talk to parents about their students failing grades

Summer school

- Considering doing some type of summer school for students
 - Still figuring out all logistics on this. How many students are needing this extra help? Hard to say a specific number as there are many students that need the help in different aspects; some need it specifically for learning content that they failed while others want more help in general
 - Enrichment program and remediation program
 - Consider an alignment of structure with summer packet
 - Also put this in the survey with the other calendar inquiry to hear feedback from parents
