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# ☐ Approval of Minutes from January 29, 2021

- o 264 at CLA
- o 192 at VPA MS

- Total of 567 students at both buildings

## **□** Recruitment Strategies

The committee discussed taking mailers/flyers to local community businesses or community events to promote schools also maybe also handing out some type of item with our school name. Ideas to handout: Bracelets, Hand sanitizer, Goodie bag; Dates/Times for potential recruitment were suggested and tasks to plan this with time to prepare materials needed were determined.

#### ☐ Remote/Hybrid Update

- o 2<sup>nd</sup> day of hybrid model
  - CLA has 182 remote students and VPA has 137 remote students; 284 students that are hybrid
- Check-Ins of students at both schools have both been going well and 6ft. of social distancing is being maintained
- Administrators have been talking to all classes of hybrid students letting them know all the procedures and requirements
- ☐ Q4 Assessment (CMAS, PSAT, SAT, MAPS, Acadience, STAR)





- o CDE has requested a partial waiver for CMAS to the US Department of Education
  - US Department approved the waiver
  - Even grades (4, 6, 8) will be taking CMAS Math
  - Odd grade (3, 5, 7) will be taking CMAS ELA
  - 8<sup>th</sup> grade will also take CMAS Science
  - Parents may opt their student in to take Math or ELA
- PSAT and SAT have been scheduled
- o EOY MAPS has been scheduled for May (2<sup>nd</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade)
  - Acadience has been scheduled for early May (K-3<sup>rd</sup> grade)
- o CogAT (2<sup>nd</sup> grade)

  - 4.9% positivity rate
  - 282.98 incidence rate
  - 104 cases within the Adams District
  - Many testing sites are starting to close
