

	Enrollment Update: 32021-2022: 26 registered for PreK; 2 sections K-4; 3 sections for 5 th = 310 registered
	for fall as of today
	Outreach/New student registration: committee discussed promotional items and outreach plans over the
	summer; the committee asked what is done for students who withdraw and do not show a transfer school; reach out to students who have left
	PK Program Update: committee discussed expanding PreK to add another classroom
	Summer Programming: Administration discussed using the computers for remediation and acceleration –
	incorporating the summer packets into the plans for summer work in courses; also discussed staff check-in-
	with students through Schoology; tracking progress, etc.
	2021-2022 Budget: Admin and the committee discussed the purchase of the K-5 math program, PPE,
	advertisement, and starting transportation again plus other impacts from COVID and declining enrollment.
	BOD Opening – discussed process for applying and encouraged committee to consider opening and reach
	out to anyone who may be interested
	Planning/Open Discussion: committee discussed possible fall family events, community, music
