ABOUT US: Community Leadership Academy (CLA) is a charter school authorized by the Charter School Institute and located in Commerce City, Colorado (within Adams County School District 14 boundaries). The school opened in 2005 and serves over 350 students in grades PK-5. The student population is 93% minority, 82% qualify for free/reduced price meals, and 63% English learners (exceeds local district by 8%). The school's education program includes Core Knowledge Sequence®, Direct Instruction, English immersion, English language acquisition support, character education, PBIS, uniform dress code, and longer school day and year. Victory Preparatory Academy Middle/High School serves over 250 students in grades 6-12 on a separate campus providing a 4-day school week. Programming includes classical education with science and technology strands, English immersion, English language acquisition support, PBIS, character education, extracurricular activities, and uniform dress code.
